REX'S GIFT CONTINUES TO CHANGE LIVES

Rex Elson, a Freemason who had been a member of the Redcliffe First Settlement Lodge since 1947, made a gift in his Will that has improved the quality of life for people with disabilities in the local Redcliffe region.

Thanks to his gift, Hand Heart Pocket was able to buy land and property to support Horizons Respite and Recreation Association Inc, which offers practical help and support to individuals with intellectual or multiple disabilities and their families.

Horizons was originally established by a small group of local mothers who wanted better care for their disabled sons and daughters. It initially operated out of a house and unit, which restricted the level of service it could offer and the number of families it could help.

Since Rex's gift helped provide purpose-built premises, Horizons has been able to expand from eight to over 55 clients and is a vital local resource in helping reduce isolation and improve quality of life for those disadvantaged by disability.

Our Grassroots Initiatives

We work closely with Lodges at a grassroots level to identify areas of need to directly help community charitable initiatives. Our Grassroots initiatives include:

- Dollar-for-Dollar Grants We match the fundraising efforts of Lodges, Dollar-for-Dollar for an approved charitable initiative.
- Dollar-for-Dollar Plus Grants We provide a top up over and above the Dollar-for-Dollar Grant to ensure a vital community initiative can come to fruition.
- Community Grants We provide a small number of grants each year to local charitable initiatives that require no fundraising from Lodges. The number, dollar value and criteria for these grants varies each year depending on the community needs.

Our Significant Grants

Our significant investments provide large donations to organisations needing a hand up, to ensure they can deliver essential services to those who rely on them. Our significant investments comprise fewer recipients but have a more significant impact for organisations in need.



Our Flagship Grants

Our flagship investments provide substantial monetary grants to meet large and strategic areas of unmet need. Our previous flagship donations have supported research to assist in the fight against dementia, a cancer wellness centre, and education and employment for youth with disability.



MAKING A WILL THAT CARES IN THE WAY YOU CARE

Drawing up your Will is one of the most important actions you will ever take to look after those you care about. Every person is an individual, and each financial situation is different, so we strongly recommend that you consult with your legal adviser before drafting a new Will or updating an existing one.

Naturally, you will want to make sure that your family and loved ones are cared for first but, depending on your circumstances, you can support the work of Hand Heart Pocket by leaving a gift in your Will in the following ways:

A gift of a specific sum of money

The remainder (residue) of your Estate after other beneficiaries have been paid

A gift of property or shares etc

The whole of your Estate if you do not have other dependants to provide for

You can either leave your gift to be used in whichever way Hand Heart Pocket thinks most appropriate, or you can specify the sort of initiative for which you would like your gift to be used.

How to word your gift in your Will

Your legal adviser will be able to give you further guidance but the following wording is a typical instruction. Note that Hand Heart Pocket the Charity of Freemasons Queensland is the trading name for Board of Benevolence, so legally you need to name Board of Benevolence as beneficiary in your Will.

I give to The Board of Benevolence and of Aged Masons Widows and Orphans' Fund (ABN 54 216 065 828) trading as Hand Heart Pocket the Charity of Freemasons Queensland of Mosaic, Level 1, 826 Ann Street, Fortitude Valley, QLD, 4017[(the whole) or (a specific amount or gift) or (a percentage) or (the residue)] of my estate free of all duties to be applied for purposes as its directors may determine. I declare that the receipt of the treasurer or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my
